May you all be blessed this season, in every way.


I'm not finding much in the way of fishing, these days: if you have any ideas, how I can do it without my flatlander blood congealing like Solareze under UV, let me know.

THE WHITE ELEPHANT GIFT EXCHANGE

Please bring a WHITE ELEPHANT gift for each of person attending. Note that a white elephant gift is something that you no longer need, but might be useful to someone else.

The party starts (eating) at 6:00 instead of the usual 7:00 so that the kitchen staff can prepare all the pizzas.

The club will provide all the pizza and salad and nonalcoholic drinks that you can consume—so come early and be prepared for a good time.







WHITE ELEPHANT

(or sometimes called the Dirty Santa Exchange)

RULES:

- Each person should bring a used gift that may be useful to someone else <u>or</u> bring a new gift that costs less than \$25. Wrap the gift.
- 2. Each person shall draw a popsicle stick to determine order of play.
- 3. Whoever is first, selects a gift and unwraps it for all to see.
- 4. Whoever is second can either select an unopened gift from the pile or steal the gift from the first person who then selects a new gift. They cannot steal their original gift back.
- 5. This continues with each person having the chance to choose an unclaimed gift or steal a gift from someone else.
- 6. A gift cannot be stolen more than three times. If your gift is stolen, no immediate takesies backsies.
- 7. Each participant cannot be stolen from more than 3 times.
- 8. When all gifts have been unwrapped, the person who drew #1 is allowed one more turn to make the final steal or choose to keep what they already have. If #1 is satisfied and keeps their gift, the game ends. If they choose to steal, they simply trade their gift and the game ends.
